

## **ADOPT AN UNDERGRAD SCHOLARSHIP**

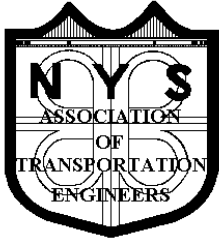
### **Adopt an Undergrad Scholarship Criteria:**

- ✚ Candidates must submit original transcript with the application. If awarded a scholarship, an original transcript must be submitted the end of junior year of college.
